We are a Reconciling in Christ congregation with diverse membership and a strong mission of community service and social action. We have a vibrant, multifaceted music program that includes both Lutheran liturgical tradition and contemporary, jazz, global, and folk music. Our chapel has a K. Kawai Grand piano, and a 4-rank Moeller organ installed in 1972 with 7 additional ranks added in 2000.

Principal Accompanist (Pianist and Organist). The candidate will provide expert piano and organ accompaniment for our services and choir rehearsals. She/he may also play in small combo groups for preludes, offertories, or postludes.
